

### **Personal Care: Internal Radiation Therapy**

## What is internal radiation treatment? (Brachytherapy)

- Brachytherapy is a precise radiation treatment delivered internally to treat patients for cancer.
- This treatment limits radiation exposure to healthy tissues.
- 3 to 6 treatments may be required.

#### How do I receive each treatment?

- Treatments will be scheduled by the nurse for a period of 2-3 hours, but the actual time will vary.
- The doctor will insert special devices during a pelvic exam
- Once properly positioned, a team of physicists will create a custom plan for that day's treatment.
- Treatment is delivered within 6-10 minutes once approved by the doctor.

#### Are there side effects to treatment?

Although the actual treatment is painless, there may be side effects including:

- Urinary tract irritation
- Loose bowel movements/diarrhea
- Vaginal discomfort, burning or discharge
- Spotting or light vaginal bleeding
- Fatigue and tiredness
- Soreness within the vagina

#### How should I treat side effects?

Urinary Irritation:

Pyridium- can soothe bladder pain
Loose Bowel Movement/Diarrhea
Immodium- up to 8 per day
Prescription strength medicines
Vaginal discomfort/burning/discharge
Start douching 2-3 times/day

### Mix into holder:

# 1-2 caps hydrogen peroxide1 quart lukewarm water

- 1. With mixture in bag, sit on toilet.
- 2. Insert applicator into vagina, allow fluid to drain into toilet.
- 3. May repeat as necessary.
